

## Significant award for the project "CULTURAL DIPOLE"

On Thursday the 25<sup>th</sup> of October 2018 the "Destination of Sustainable Cultural Tourism 2018 Awards" ceremony was held in Pafos, Cyprus. The **CULTURAL DIPOLE** project, which is funded by "Interreg V-A Greece-Bulgaria 2014-2020" Cooperation Programme, won **the second prize in the category "Transnational Thematic Tourism"**. In the ceremony participated: the **Mayor of Serres Petros Aggelidis** and **Prof. Aristotelis Naniopoulos**, scientific coordinator of the project for AUTH.

The award contest was organised by the **European Cultural Tourism Network (ECTN)** in cooperation with **Europa Nostra** and **European Travel Commission**, supported by the **Network of European Regions of Competitive and Sustainable Tourism (NECSTour)**. In total 57 candidates from 15 countries had submitted applications, under 7 thematic categories. The implementation of the contest is a contribution to the **European Year of Cultural Heritage (EYCH2018)**.
